

Common Wood Problems:

Burns: Use 000 or finer high grade steel wool to rub area - always with the grain. Use a light touch until smooth. Apply furniture oil or polish.

Water Rings: Mix equal parts of white vinegar and cooking oil. Rub water rings with the grain.

Heat Marks: Use mayonnaise to coat the heated area. Let stand for one hour, then wipe clean. Polish when finished.

Candle Wax: Scrape off the candle wax with a credit card. Take off thin layers of wax until you get almost to the finish. Remove the rest with wood cleaner and then apply polish.

Dents: Wipe off the dented area with warm water. Place a water soaked cloth compress over the dented area and let sit for 30 minutes. Next place a warm iron over the cloth compress for short intervals until the dent is gone. Apply polish when finished.
